Dear Assembly Member Salas:

The Elections Legislative Committee of the California Association of Clerks and Election Officials (CACEO) reviewed **AB 917** (as introduced February 22, 2007). This bill would require that on Direct Recording Electronic (DRE) voting systems no contests under separate headings shall appear on the same page. The bill also requires that in counties utilizing DRE voting systems, paper ballots shall be provided at the polls. We understand that the intention is to amend the bill to require that the number of paper ballots provided equal 10% of the registration of the precinct in a General Election, and 5% of the registration of each political party in a Primary Election.

Requiring each contest under a specific heading appear on a separate page on a DRE would require a rewrite of the software which would result in the systems having to go back through federal and state certification. This would be very costly, and though the costs are to be borne by the vendors, they must pass the increases along to the jurisdictions purchasing the equipment/upgrade. Further, a ballot laid out in such a manner would result in numerous screens and pages, the outcome of which would be voter fatigue and undoubtedly additional voter drop-off for "down-ballot" contests. We understand this legislation was prompted by a problem that occurred in Florida. We do not believe similar problems would be encountered in California, and have included copies of screen prints of DRE ballots for your reference.

Based on costs incurred as a result of conditions previously placed on the use of DRE's in California, the estimated statewide cost of providing paper ballots at the polls in DRE counties is between \$750,000 and \$1,000,000, respectively, for each Primary and General Election.
